

Third Sunday of Advent Reflection.

The messiah's coming requires every man and woman to choose to "repent" or not. Repentance translates a Greek word, metanoia (change of mind). In the Scriptures, repentance is presented as a twofold "turning" away from sin This "turning" is more than attitude adjustment. It means a radical life change. It requires good fruits as evidence of your repentance. We should examine our lives, asking from our hearts as they did: What should we do? Our repentance should spring not from our fear of coming but from a joyful sense of the nearness of our saving God.

Worldwide Synod:

The synodality process which began three years ago and involved parishes, like our own, meeting and seeking to discern the needs of the church came to a close at the end of October with the second synod meeting in Rome. Pope Francis has published the report of the synod. We will produce a summary of that report in due course for you to read. Some issues such as the ordination of women have been handed to commissions to research and discuss further. It did however recognise the importance of giving all the baptised a greater voice in the decision making of the Church including the choice of Bishops.
